

Call for Papers: Annual Meeting of the South-Central Chapter of the American Musicological Society, March 2-3, 2012.

Deadline for Submissions: Saturday, January 7, 2012.

The South-Central Chapter of the American Musicological Society (AMS-SC) is pleased to announce its 2012 Annual Meeting, to be hosted by Union University in Jackson, Tennessee. The meeting will begin on the morning of Friday, March 2, and will conclude by noon on Saturday, March 3. Proposals for presentations, special sessions, papers with a performance component, and panel discussions are solicited on any topic related to historical musicology. Presentations will be limited to twenty minutes, with an additional ten minutes allotted for questions and discussion. Proposals should include an abstract of no more than 250 words, suitable for publication. Abstracts should be concise but thorough and clearly indicate the scope of your research, the research methods employed, and your conclusions. Please include the proposal's title at the top of the page and indicate the author's name, mailing address, email address, phone number, institutional affiliation or place of residence, and AV equipment needs at the bottom. For a proposal submitted by a student, a separate email message from an adviser or other faculty member should be sent to the Program Committee Chair to verify student status. Student members of the AMS-SC whose abstracts are selected by the program committee will be eligible to compete in the Rey M. Longyear Student Paper Competition. This award, given in memory of Professor Longyear, will be announced at the chapter meeting.
